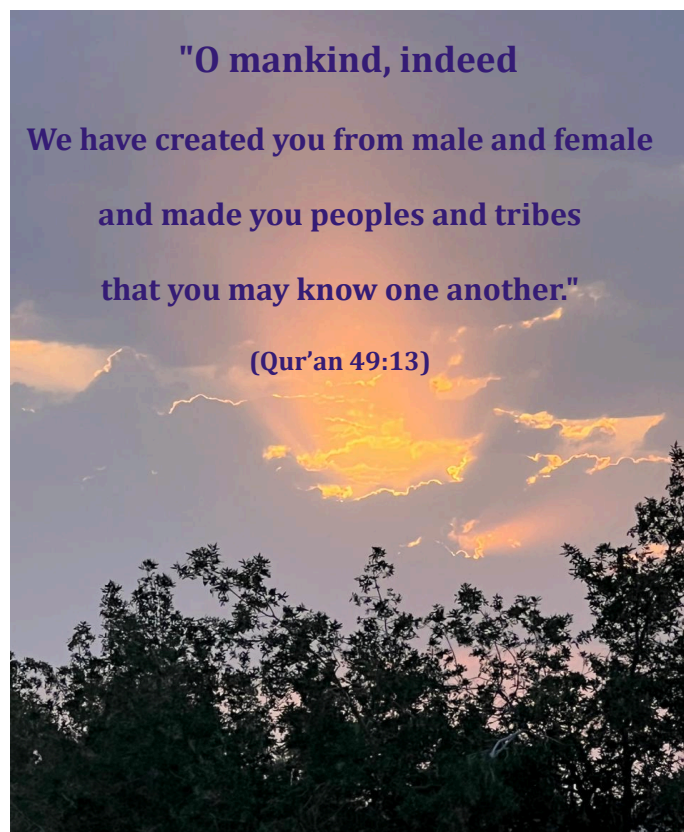

## Golden Manner of the Month

Based on the hadith, *“He who is not grateful to people will not be grateful to God,”* here are 10 simple ways students can show gratitude in school:

1. Always say **Alhamdulillah** for everything that happens.
2. **Saying "Thank You":** Always say "thank you or Jazakum Allahu Khair" to teachers, classmates, and staff for their help or kindness.
3. **Helping Others:** Offer to help a classmate or a staff member who may need help with a task or needs assistance.
4. **Listening Attentively:** Show respect and gratitude to teachers by listening quietly and attentively during lessons.
5. **Writing Notes of Thanks:** Create small thank-you cards for teachers, staff, or friends who have been kind or helpful.
6. **Cleaning Up:** Help clean the classroom or tidy up shared spaces like the classroom, library or playground.
7. **Appreciating Acts of Kindness:** Compliment or acknowledge classmates when they do something nice, like holding the door or helping carry something.
8. **Make Duas for Others:** Include teachers, friends, and staff in your Duas, asking Allah (swt) to bless them.
9. **Showing Respect:** Treat everyone in school—teachers, classmates, and staff—with kindness, politeness, and respect.
10. **Smiling Often:** A simple smile can show gratitude and spread positivity to those around them.
